Mayor Dineen called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. Meeting was held online using Zoom Video Communications due to the Coronavirus.

**Public Comment:**

Trustee Whalen reminded the residents that it is their responsibility to shovel their sidewalks in front of their property after it snows. The municipality snow blows the sidewalks only as a courtesy as time allows.

Mayor Dineen clarified Department of Public Works will eventually get around to doing the sidewalks after they get a handle on the snowstorm but it is the residents' responsibility to clear their sidewalks. Mayor Dineen stated there is also no overnight parking on the streets. Residents should be parking overnight in the designated municipal parking lot or in their driveways.

Trustee Ganance arrived at the meeting at 6:09 p.m.

Village Board discussed the contract from R & R Logging. Mayor Dineen stated Jeff Moller, Supt. of Public Works, checked references on R & R Logging and they all came back very positive. Mayor Dineen stated she will follow-up with R & R Logging to get clarification on the contract regarding the excess branches being chipped and that the grading of the property will be reestablished as original not replanted. Mayor Dineen stated the minimum revenue the Village can expect is \$40-\$50,000.
