General Rules and Regulations

Smoke Free Facility

- "Carry In-Carry Out" Policy
- Park only in designated areas
- Metal detectors prohibited
- Open fires in designated areas only
- No cutting, carving, or defacing of trees, shrubs, etc.
- No destruction or defacing of Village property
- No off-road motorized vehicles allowed
- No overnight parking allowed
- All use of Village grounds, fields, courts, and specified areas are at one's own risk
- The Village is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property
- Restrooms are available in recreation pavilion
- No bare feet except in pool area
- Negative behavior jeopardizes use of the park
- All children 14 and under MUST be accompanied by an adult 18 and older
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times and waste needs to be picked up
- Skates, bicycles and skateboard riders must have helmets and other appropriate safety gear



Pool Rules:

- *Pool open only when lifeguard is on duty
- *No diving, pushing, running, or rough play in pool area
- *No food or drink allowed in pool area
- *No glass on the pool deck
- *Please use bathrooms provided
- *Proper pool attire required
- *Life vests must be Coast Guard approved

Field & Court Rules:

- *First come first use basis
- *Organized teams must submit a Request for Use of Park Facilities form & Certificate of Insurance (available online or at Village Office)
- *No climbing or sitting on fences or backstops
- *Proper footwear required
