Zoning Reminders for Residents and Businesses

Residents

As this season of home improvement projects begins, residents should be aware that the following projects; decks, fences, roofs, pools, and sheds, require a building permit from our Building and Zoning inspector.

Additionally, any unregistered vehicles may only be stored in an enclosed garage while camping, RV, trailers and work related equipment must be kept in the <u>rear</u> of the owner's property.

When visiting any of the Village parks, please remember that there is a carry in-carryout policy for trash and our parks have a smoke-free designation and we ask that you help create a clean and healthy environment for all village residents and visitors to enjoy.

Businesses and Organizations

Please remember that each business and organization is allowed to display one sandwich board style sign during their regular operating hours. The sign may be placed on the sidewalk where it does not impede pedestrian flow, sight line or create other hazards and pulled in once business hours have closed.

Organizations may place a sandwich board sign in Orsini Park one week prior to their event with permission from the Village. Please contact the Village clerk to make arrangements.

We also ask business owners to remind their delivery drivers to only stop and unload in designated parking areas. Finally, any business or organization wishing to host an event in one of our beautiful parksplease contact the Village Hall to check availability and fill out an application.

Summer at Bozenkill Park

It is that time of year again! Bozenkill Park will officially open from May 25- October 7th 2019. The Village pool season will begin on June 15th and remain open until September 1, 2019. Our park hours begin at 10:00 am and close at 7:00 pm Monday through Friday, with pool hours from noon-7:00 pm.
